## **Re: Keeping In Touch**

I hope that you are all staying safe and well and looking after one another. I am writing to express my gratitude for all of the hard work and efforts from our pupils and parents in engaging with our new way of learning.

BSc (Hons), MA Please be assured that we expect our pupils to work at a pace that is appropriate to them and allows them to make progress. We do not expect them to work solidly for 5 hours each day. As parents, please continue to encourage your child to work on tasks and give reassurance that it is not absolutely essential to complete all of the given tasks in an hour. Pupils should work at their own pace and be proud of their achievements.

Thank you to all the pupils and students for also keeping in touch. Year 10 pupils receive direct updates from myself on the Year 10 Google Classroom.

Naturally, Year 10 have just started their GCSEs and will be worried about what this means for them. With the exam series cancellation, pupils in Year 10 who were due to sit some unit examinations in the summer will not be issued with a predicted grade like year 11 pupils. For Year 10 pupils, there will be two options available:

1. Sit only the Year 11 unit exam(s) in the summer 2021, with the final overall GCSE grade calculated based on their performance only in these Year 11 units; or

2. Sit the Year 10 units and the Year 11 units in summer 2021. With this option, the examination board will also consider the grade they would have been awarded if they took option 1.

Their final grade will be the best grade awarded from either option. This important decision on whether to follow option 1 or 2 will be guided by your teachers in due course. Please do not worry too much unnecessarily about it now, however it is important that you continue with whatever home learning is possible given your circumstances.
